d) VAS (Vehicle Activated Sign) Northbound

The Clerk is awaiting a cost from the supplier to provide speed monitoring software on the new VAS sign.

e) VAS Southbound

An officer from Shropshire Highways has confirmed that he is looking into the request of this Council to replace the Southbound VAS.

f) Wootton Lane to the New Barns

The Clerk has again written to the owner of adjoining land about the problem of water running on to the road.

12. REVIEW OF ELECTORAL DIVISIONS IN SHROPSHIRE

The Local Government Boundary Commission has published its final recommendations on the review of electoral divisions in Shropshire.

There will be 74 members of the Unitary Authority, representing 2 two councillor divisions and 70 single member divisions. As in the draft recommendations, the present Alveley and Claverley Division will be abolished and a new single member division called Bridgnorth South and Alveley will be created. This will include Alveley, Quatford and Quatt but Claverley will be moved into a new division with Worfield. A plan of the new divisions is attached.

Subject to approval by Parliament, the final recommendations will come into effect at the local government elections in 2025.
