## e) Danger to Pedestrians at Wootton Lane

It was noted that the Clerk had procured signs to warn motorists of the danger posed by pedestrians using the lane. Permission was being sought from the National Trust to erect the signs on its property.

## f) Bollards at Wootton Lane

### <u>Resolved</u>

ii) That if the resident so requested, the Parish Council would endeavour to obtain permission for him to park on the drive of the Old Vicarage whilst tending the garden.
