e) Financial Progress

f) National Salary Award

The National Salary Award for employees of local councils has been agreed for 2024-25. The award is effective from 1^{st} April 2024 and will result in the salary of the Clerk being increased from £13.50 per hour (scale point 11) to £14.13 per hour. A copy of the new scales is attached.

The Clerk is currently employed on a contract of 4 hours per week and the award would therefore cost the Council an extra £131.04 per annum.

In addition, there would be back pay owing from 1^{st} April 2024 which amounts to £87.32.

The Council is requested to approve the new salary scale and back pay with effect from 1st April 2024.

9. GRANTS AND DONATIONS

The Council will recall that local organizations were invited back in the Spring to submit applications for grants to be considered at this meeting.

St. Andrew's Parochial Church Council has submitted an application for the installation of a new sound system. The total cost of the system is just under £5700.00 of which the Church have managed to raise £2000.00 so far from other sources. Details of the Church Accounts and other information is attached.

The Council has made a budget allocation of £1500.00 for grants to outside organizations this year.

11. NEW MODEL FINANCIAL REGULATIONS

At the last meeting, the Chairman raised a point concerning paragraph 2.6 of the version of the Regulations prepared by the Clerk. It was resolved that this version be adopted but that the Clerk consider whether the wording at Para 2.6 could be amended to avoid the need to use a person other than a signatory to verify the accounts.

The Clerk has checked the point which can be amended and he recommends that the wording in question be deleted.

Despite the best efforts of the local member of Shropshire Council, Mr Colin Taylor, it has not been possible to arrange a meeting between Shropshire Highways and Quatt Malvern and Alveley and Romsley Parish Councils.

Following the last meeting, the Clerk has contacted a number of companies who carry out independent traffic surveys. Whilst some of the companies have requested more information, which the Clerk will try and provide, one firm has indicated a price of $\pounds 575.00 + VAT$ To carry out a survey in both Quatt and Alveley.
