TRESPASS AND DAMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT

A number of residents have reported instances of off road vehicles and motorcycles trespassing on land around Quatt, often resulting in damage to rights of way and adjoining land. Areas of the Dudmaston Estate have been affected particularly badly.

The problem seems to have become worse since the Lockdown has been imposed and it is believed that some of the groups of people involved have been in breach of Lockdown Regulations.

Shropshire Council, the National Trust and the Police have been working together to try and prevent these occurrences, without of course hindering those people who are enjoying the facility of the countryside in a lawful and responsible way.
