26.ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

At the meeting of 25th March, the Parish Council agreed that the Annual Parish Meeting be held on Thursday 27th May at 7.00pm. It now seems clear that this meeting will have to be a face to face meeting in the Quatt Village Hall. The Judicial Review against the decision of the Government to not extend the legislation allowing the holding of remote meetings has been unsuccessful. This gives rise to the following implications:

- a) Social distancing will need to be observed at the meeting and seats for the public will have to be limited to a first come first served basis if the capacity of the Hall is to not be exceeded.
- b) It is recommended that no refreshments be provided, other than bottles of water for the speakers.
- c) The Hall will need to be cleansed after the meeting. The Village Hall Committee can arrange for this to be carried out with a steam cleaner although there is a charge for this service.
